Thanks to all who made the spring tree giveaway a success, with 25 trees finding a new home.

While you will want to stake and tie trees for support this should only be done for the first year and then removed. Flexing of the trunk in the wind actually promotes root growth and makes for a stronger tree. Also remove any tags as well as ties as they can trap moisture against the bark which can promote disease.

Thankfully the drought ended with the steady rains we've had in late June. Although newly planted, the native species of berry and nut trees planted in the clearing near the sledding hill seem to be off to a good start. This area was planted and fenced by contractors working with the city forestry department. As it matures it will be a great source of food for wildlife and people!

Have you noticed the flower garden at the head of the Tyndale trail and at our community marker? This has been an ongoing project to create a beautiful entrance to the park and our community while providing food for a variety of birds, butterflies and bees. Thanks go out to our volunteers as well as the folks from Cylburn Arboretum for donating plants for our gardens. 




