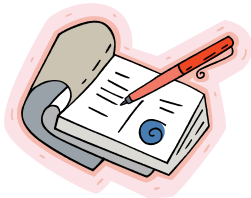

## President's Message

With summer fully upon us we have a return of both positive and negative seasonal trends. With the combination of ample rain, combined with warm and sunny days neighborhood gardens are bursting with flowers and homegrown produce is starting to be harvested. Unfortunately due to the aforementioned rain a couple of the Tuesday markets at the site of the future community commercial kitchen at 4500 Harford Rd., across from Safeway, have been cancelled at the last minute. Weather permitting though the market remains open on Tuesday evenings through September. This is a great place to grab some good food truck grub, buy hyper-local produce and honey right from the neighborhood, and try some hula-hooping!

On a less happy note there has been a rash of burglaries reported in Arcadia in the last few weeks as well as a murder at the corner of Harford and Cold Spring Lane. Crime statistics show that these burglaries are unfortunately becoming rather routine at the beginning of summer vacation. They appear to be mostly 'amateur' break-ins and fortunately only at homes where no one is home. Bob Poirer has started to organize a potential 'neighborhood watch'. In the meanwhile heightened vigilance is paying off. A neighbor on Harcourt observed a potential break-in of a neighbor's shed and called it in to 911.

Police responded, followed up with vehicle information and a description, and apparently made an arrest.

The apparent targeted murder of the locally well-known Baltimore rapper Lor Scoota as he was leaving an event at Morgan State is a tragedy. It was an event to foster peace on the streets of Baltimore. It is sad that the violence that plagues the city occasionally intrudes into or is uncomfortably close to our generally peaceful neighborhood. It is a reminder to be thankful for the relative calm and safety and graciousness of our neighbors.

## Park Dumping is Illegal

A reminder that if you live in walking distance of our beautiful park, it is **NOT okay** to dump yard waste, trimmed shrubs, or tree branches in the park. It is environmentally bad for the soil and stream because yard waste often contain animal droppings, plant pesticides or fertilizers. Bag your clippings, bundle pruned branches in 3 foot lengths and the city will take them away with the trash. If you see someone dumping items in the park, call 311 and report their car tag #. ## Arcadia Crime Alert

June brought a new wave of home break-ins to  
our neighborhood. Entry was gained through win-  
dows and doors not easily seen by a next door  
neighbor. Sometimes valuables were taken  
but the thought of someone going through your  
personal belongings is never welcomed. If you  
return home to an open door that you know was  
locked when you left--call 911 before you enter  
the house, the person may still be in your house.  
Consider getting an alarm with an outside audible  
sound--it will alert at home neighbors. If property  
is taken from your yard, car, or garage, call 911  
to report it. Even the smaller crimes that you feel  
were your neglect for not locking up, need to be  
reported. Crimes of opportunity are still CRIME!  
Be a good neighbor and call if you see something  
that just doesn't seem right.

**A storm drain?** Who would give that a second thought? It's not so unlikely if you are an environmentally conscious person. It doesn't cost you anything but time and a bit of exercise. The benefit is all yours, because you get to burn a few extra calories and save a bottle, plastic bag, food wrapper, paper anything, can, and whatever else might get dropped on the street from reaching our watershed. Consider this as an option to support clean waterways. Just once a week check your closest storm drain for recyclables and just plain old trash. By keeping the storm drains open it helps to eliminate water back-up that might end up flooding basements.

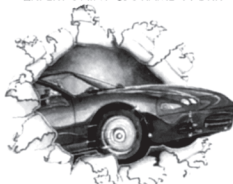
